Vouvray La Craie is 100% Chenin Blanc custom cuvée from hillside parcels just outside the village of Vouvray. Produced from young vines (15- 25 years old), this bottling is almost always a light demi-sec. A delicious introduction to Chenin Blanc!

The 2017 Planetes de Nin comes from the four hectares of 20-year-old Garnacha and 11-year-old Cariñena in the Planetes vineyard in Porrera. It's 60% Garnacha and the rest Cariñena, harvested early. It has depth and harmony, and the vines are getting older and seem to be better and better balanced.

The family of Livio Sassetti produces wine in Montalcino for over three generations. The Podere Pertimali and its 16 hectares of vineyards are located in the Montosoli area, north of Montalcino, a particularly well-known area for the cultivation of the Sangiovese. Faithful to the teachings of his family Livio has over time renewed & expanded the vineyards, preserving the genetic heritage of the old vines & preserving the primigenie characteristics.
